1. MINI SOCCER & YOUTH PLAYERS

WHEN PLAYING FOOTBALL I WILL:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team
- Play fairly – I will not cheat, dive, complain or waste time
- Treat all my squad members and team mates with respect at all times
- Respect the opposition team and coaches, the referee and my coach/manager
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with other team members, opposition team and referee at the end of each match
- Listen and respond to what my coach/manager tells me
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player
- Talk to someone I trust or the Club Welfare Officer (Catherine O’Connell - 07884 496996) if I am unhappy about anything or being unfairly treated by anyone at my Club.

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DO NOT FOLLOW THIS CODE, ANY/ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS MAY BE TAKEN BY MY CLUB, THE COUNTY FA OR THE FA:

I MAY:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, opposition team, referee or team manager
- Understand that my parents or carers will be made aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- Receive a formal warning from the Coach or Club Committee
- Be dropped from the team or suspended by the Club



- Be suspended from training
- Be asked to leave the Club

IN ADDITION:

- My Club, County FA or The FA may be made aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- The County FA/The FA could impose a fine or suspension against my Club.
