CODE OF CONDUCT SPECTATORS



1. SPECTATORS

We all bear a collective responsibility to set a good example and provide a positive environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game of football. Please play your part and observe the Club's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators at all times.

I WILL:

- Remember that children play for fun
- Support positively and do not criticise
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Respect the Referee's decisions even when you don't always agree with them
- Appreciate good play from both teams
- Remain behind the respect barrier and within the designated spectators' area
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Set a good example by respecting the opposition and encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee, and other match officials
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour
- Report to a Chipstead Coach or Official (at half time or the end of a match) any unsportsmanlike conduct witnessed rather than take matters into my own hands
- Refrain from consuming alcohol at any of the Chipstead Football Grounds.

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DO NOT FOLLOW THIS CODE, ANY/ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS MAY BE TAKEN BY THE CLUB:

I MAY BE:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a Club/League official
- Required to meet with the Club and/or Club Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the Club Committee
- Asked to leave the match venue by a Club Official (Coach/Committee Member/Club Welfare Officer)
- Requested by the Club not to attend future games
- Required to leave the Club along with any dependents

IN ADDITION:

- The County FA/The FA could impose a fine and/or suspension against the Club.
